Mega Blood Donation Camp

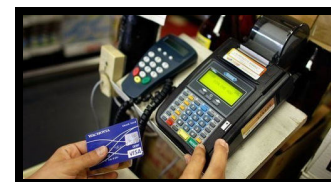

GUEST TALKS

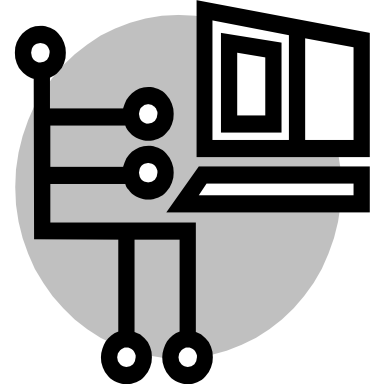

Six 1st year students **MBA College** participated in the Krishna University Intercollegiate Cricket Tournament and won the match at Vuyyuru and were sent to

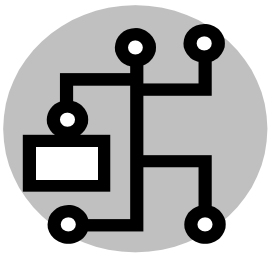
represent East Zone.

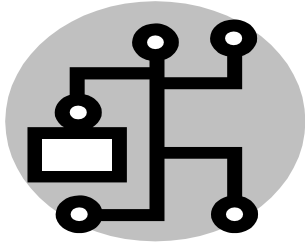

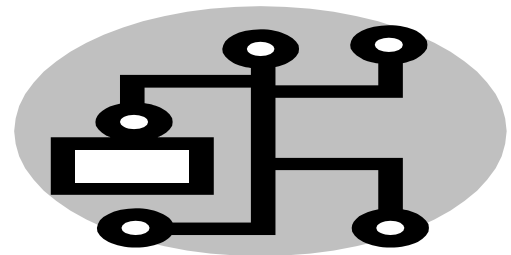
